ATLANTIC COUNTY MUNICIPAL JOINT INSURANCE FUND RESOLUTION #2018-34

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FUND CHAIR AND SECRETARY TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND TO MAKE ALL NECESSARY PAYMENTS TO CONCLUDE AND SETTLE THE <u>HARRY SCHEELER, JR. VS. ACM JIF</u> MATTER, AND AUTHORIZING THE FUND TREASURER TO PAY TO THE PLAINTIFF'S ATTORNEYS THEIR FEES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$38,000.00 FROM THE FUND YEAR 2016 RESERVES.

WHEREAS, the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund (hereinafter the "FUND") has been organized pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40A:10-36 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the FUND is duly constituted as a Municipal Self Insurance Fund to provide insurance coverage to its member municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the FUND is subject to the provisions of the Open Public Records Act (N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 et seq.) (hereinafter OPRA); and

WHEREAS, Harry Scheeler, Jr. had made numerous OPRA requests of the FUND including information requests in 2016 requesting copies of detailed legal bills for both ongoing and concluded litigated matters pertaining to members of the FUND; and

WHEREAS, in response to those requests, the FUND provided summary invoices only for the ongoing litigated actions; and

WHEREAS, a civil complaint was filed against the FUND by Harry Scheeler, Jr. in 2016 challenging the FUND's position that detailed legal bills for ongoing litigated matters being defended by the FUND on behalf of its member municipalities were not subject to the provisions of the Open Public Records Act; and

WHEREAS, this civil matter is captioned as <u>Harry Scheeler</u>, <u>Jr. vs. ACM JIF</u>, <u>Docket No.</u> <u>BUR-L-990-15</u>; and

WHEREAS, Superior Court Judge Bookbinder of Burlington County determined that the Plaintiff was entitled to receive the detailed legal bills for ongoing litigated matters and that the FUND should be responsible to pay the Plaintiff's legal expenses and costs totaling \$21,560.12; and

WHEREAS, the FUND authorized the filing of an appeal of Judge Bookbinder's decision; and

WHEREAS, Superior Court decisions in other jurisdictions regarding similar issues were also filed with the Appellate Division and those cases were consolidated with the <u>Harry Scheeler</u>, <u>Jr. vs.</u> <u>ACM JIF</u> matter in the Appellate Division; and

WHEREAS, in a decision dated May 16, 2018, the Appellate Division affirmed Superior Court Judge Bookbinder's decision in the *Harry Scheeler, Jr. vs. ACM JIF* matter, and in addition to the attorney's fees award by Judge Bookbinder in the Superior Court matter, the FUND was required to pay the Plaintiff's attorney's fees for the appeal totaling \$26,915.37 for a total of \$48,475.49; and

WHEREAS, the attorney representing the FUND in this matter, James R. Birchmeier, Esquire has negotiated a reduction in the amount to be paid to satisfy Plaintiff's attorney's fees to \$38,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund that the Fund Chair and Secretary are hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents and to make all necessary payments to conclude and settle the <u>Harry Scheeler, Jr. vs. ACM JIF</u> matter; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the FUND Treasurer is hereby authorized to issue payment to Pashman Stein Walder Hayden, PC in the amount of \$38,000.00 from the 2016 Reserve Accounts representing payment of Plaintiff's attorney's fees in the *Harry Scheeler*, *Jr. vs. ACM JIF* matter.

This Resolution was duly adopted by the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund at a public meeting held on June 20, 2018.
